

#### TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Registrations are not confirmed until full payment is received.
- 2. All cancellations and changes must be made in writing to admin@lgfp.org.au.
- 3. For accommodation bookings, rooms cancelled between 30 8 days prior to arrival will incur a 1 night cancellation fee. Rooms cancelled within 7 days of arrival will incur a 100% cancellation fee of the entire stay.
- 4. For conference registrations, cancellations greater than three weeks of the commencement of the event (received prior to 1 November 2022), the registration fee may be applied to a future LGFP event; or the registration may be transferred to another delegate; or a refund will be provided less a \$50 administration fee.
- 5. For conference registrations cancelled within three weeks of the commencement of the event (received on or after 1 November 2022), no refund will be provided however the registration may be transferred to another delegate (up to seven days prior to the event).
- 6. For conference registrations cancelled within seven days of the commencement of the event (received on or after 15 November 2022), no refund will be provided.
- 7. In the event of non-attendance, no refund will be issued.
- 8. If the event is cancelled for any reason, LGFP will advise delegates within 72 hours of the event commencement date and a full refund will be issued.
- 9. If the event is able to be rescheduled, delegates will be informed of the new date. If delegates are unable to attend on the rescheduled date, a full refund will be issued. Alternatively, a delegate may request the event registration fee be applied to a future LGFP event.
